Water Assistance Research Report: Officially passed on June 13th, the Town has issued an ordinance that'll increase the water and wastewater rates. The water/wastewater department has been trailing deep into the red for several years, and the increase deficit has threatened the Town into a predicament where it could be issued heavy fines from the State among other severe consequences.

No longer seen as a self-sufficient department, the Town requested the aid of Jean S. Holloway, Delaware & Maryland State Lead of SERCAP, where through her thorough analysis a new rate was proposed to begin reversing the damage. While the new rates are in effect starting July, customers won't see a change until October bills are posted. The new rate for water is \$50.00 and \$7.70 per 1,000 gallons after 6,000 gallons, and the new rate for sewer is \$135.00 and \$12.35 per 1,000 gallons after 6,000 gallons.

To help combat the coming changes, Clerk Jerry Jeffra has prepared a comprehensive research report detailing the hows and whys of the situation, along with an exhaustive list of local, state, federal and religious sources citizens of Snow Hill can contact to request financial assistance.
